

ELECTION INFORMATION
TUESDAY, NOVEMBER 2, 2021 – LABETTE COUNTY CITY/SCHOOL GENERAL
Election Day Voting – Open 7:AM to 7PM at all Polling Locations

VOTER REGISTRATION

You may register to vote at any of the following locations during their regular business hours: the Office of the County Clerk, Courthouse, Oswego or online www.labettecounty.com; any City Clerk's office; Department of Motor Vehicles; SRS offices, etc.; U.S. Mail (request Kansas Voter Registration Application by mail or telephone); also available in Online Voter Registration: www.voteks.org – Vote Kansas – online voter registration – follow thru as directed.

A citizen of the United States who is eighteen (18) years of age and upwards, or will have attained the age of eighteen (18) years at the next election, must register before he or she may vote.

When a voter has been registered according to law his or her registration shall continue to be valid until one of the following occurs:

1. The Voter changes residence, outside of his/her voting precinct boundary
2. The Voter fails to vote in two consecutive state/federal general elections.

If either of the above occurs, you must re-register. Any person may apply in person or by mail to the County Election Officer to re-register. The application shall be signed under penalty of perjury.

CLOSING OF REGISTRATION BOOKS

Pursuant to the provisions of KSA25-2310, 25-2311 and KAR7-23-4, notice is hereby given that on Tuesday, October 12, 2021 (last day to register to vote before the November General/20 days prior to election) all registration books for the City/School General Election will close at the end of regular business hours/day. The books will remain closed until the day following the General Election, Wednesday, November 3, 2021.

ADVANCE VOTING BY MAIL: KSA25-1123

Any registered voter is eligible to vote by Advance Ballot, beginning Wednesday October 13, 2021, 20 days prior to election. Applications for Advance Ballots are available at the Labette County Clerk/Election Office or by calling (620) 795-2138 or (620) 421-5255. A printable application for an Advance Ballot is available on the county website www.labettecounty.com or Kansas Secretary of State website www.sos.kansas.gov.

RETURNING ADVANCE BALLOTS:

In Person: Ballots must be returned by 7:00 P.M. on Election Day to any Polling Location within the County or to the County Election Office, Courthouse, 501 Merchant, Oswego.

By Mail: Ballot must be postmarked on or before 7:00 P.M., Tuesday, November 2, 2021 (Election Day) and received in County Election Office by Friday, November 5, 2021/Deadline for receipt of Advance Ballots. KSA25-1132.

EARLY VOTING KSA25-1122:

Early voting (In House/In Person) is available at Labette County Courthouse (Clerk's Office) beginning Wednesday, October 14, 2021 thru Monday, November 1, 2021 12:00 Noon.
