The outside compressor has been replaced after it quit working, but the inside compressor also needs replaced. Commissioners authorized Ms. Grassl to replace the inside compressor using the 911 fund.

Taser Purchase

Addis authorized Sheriff Darren Eichinger to purchase 18 Taser X26 Refurbished Tasers, along with the spare cartridge clips, holsters, and air cartridges for a cost of \$599.00 each for a total of \$10,782.00 from Accredited Security, using Fund 001-095-2000.
