You may register to vote at any of the following locations during their regular business hours: the Office of the County Clerk, Courthouse, Oswego or online www.labettecounty.com; any City Clerk's office; Department of Motor Vehicles; SRS offices, etc. Voter Registration is also available online at kansasvotes.org. A citizen of the United States who is eighteen (18) years of age and upwards or will have attained the age of eighteen (18) years at the next election, must register before he/she may vote. When a voter has been registered according to law his/her registration shall continue to be valid until one of the following occurs:

- 1. The Voter changes residence, outside of his/her voting precinct boundary.
- 2. The Voter fails to vote in two consecutive state/federal general elections.

If either of the above occurs, you must re-register. Any person may apply in person or by mail to the County Election Officer to re-register. The application shall be signed under penalty of perjury.

<u>CLOSING OF REGISTRATION BOOKS</u>: Pursuant to KSA 25-2310, 25-2311(e) and KAR 7-23-4 Notice is hereby given that at 5:00 P.M. on the 17th day of October, 2023 registration books for the City/School General Election will close and remain closed until the 8th day of November, 2023.

A printable application for an Advance Ballot is available on the county website www.labettecounty.com or Secretary of State website www.sos.kansas.gov. Tuesday, October 31, 2023, is the last day a voter may apply for an Advance Ballot (to be mailed) for the General Election.
