VOTER REGISTRATION:

You may register to vote at any of the following locations during their regular business hours: the Office of the County Clerk, Courthouse, Oswego or online www.labettecounty.com; any City Clerk's office; Department of Motor Vehicles; SRS offices, etc.; U.S. Mail (request Kansas Voter Registration Application by mail or telephone); also available in Online Voter Registration: www.votekansas.gov. Note: All persons wishing to check the status of their Voter Registration &/or Advance Ballot may do so by going to www.votekansas.gov.

A citizen of the United States who is eighteen (18) years of age and upwards or will have attained the age of eighteen (18) years at the next election, must register before he or she may vote.

When a voter has been registered according to law his or her registration shall continue to be valid until one of the following occurs:

1. The Voter changes residence, outside of his/her voting precinct boundary.
2. The Voter fails to vote in two consecutive state/federal general elections.

If either of the above occurs, you must re-register. Any person may apply in person or by mail to the County Election Officer to re-register. The application shall be signed under penalty of perjury.

CLOSING OF REGISTRATION BOOKS: Pursuant to the provisions of KSA 25-2310, 25-2311 and KAR 7-23-4

Notice is hereby given that on February 20, 2024 all registration books for the Presidential Preference Primary Election will close at the end of regular business hours. The books will remain closed until the day following the Presidential Preference Primary Wednesday, March 20, 2024.

PARTY AFFILIATION CHANGES &/OR DECLARATIONS: K.S.A.3304(a) &(b)

Deadline for party affiliation changes (from one recognized party to another) before the Presidential Preference Primary is February 20, 2024. An Unaffiliated voter may affiliate by submitting a voter registration application any time between now and until/including Election Day.

APPLY FOR ADVANCED BALLOT APPLICATION BY MAIL DEADLINE: K.S.A 25-1122(f)(1) [C]

Tuesday, February 20, 2024 is the last day a voter may apply for Advance Ballots (to be mailed) for the Presidential Preference Primary Election.

ADVANCE VOTING BY MAIL: KSA25-1123

Any registered voter is eligible to vote by Advance Ballot. Applications for Advance Ballots are available at the Labette County Clerk/Election Office or by calling (620) 795-2138. A printable application for an Advance Ballot is available on the county website www.labettecounty.com or Kansas Secretary of State website www.sos.kansas.gov. Advanced Ballots will be mailed out February 28, 2024.

RETURNING ADVANCE BALLOTS: KSA 25-1132

In Person/by Mail: All Ballots must be returned on or before March 19, 2024 at 7:00 P.M. on Election Day to any Polling Location within the County, or to the County Clerk/Election Office, Courthouse, 501 Merchant, Oswego.

NOTE: ALL ADVANCED BALLOTS MUST BE RETURNED ON OR BEFORE MARCH 19, 2024 AT 7:00 P.M.

EARLY VOTING: KSA25-1122

Early voting (In House/In Person) is available at Labette County Courthouse (Clerk's Office) beginning February 28, 2024 thru Monday, March 18, 2024 at 12:00 P.M. (noon).
