

Resolution No. 2022-29-L

RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF
LABETTE COUNTY, KANSAS, PROHIBITING THE USE OF DESIGNATED ROADWAYS
AS THROUGH WAYS BY CERTAIN VEHICLES

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners shall have home rule authority to legislate on matters of local concern; and

WHEREAS, K.S.A. 8-2002, and amendments thereto, authorizes the Board of County Commissioners to prohibit or regulate the use of heavily traveled streets and roads by any class or kind of traffic that is found incompatible with normal and safe movement of traffic; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners by a unanimous vote passed Resolution No. 2022-25-L prohibiting the use of designated roadways as through ways by certain vehicles; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners in section 2 of said resolution designated certain streets and roadways not for use by vehicles exceeding certain registered gross vehicle weights, including for agricultural purposes, in the unincorporated area of Labette County, Kansas.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of Labette County, Kansas, that the following traffic regulation be and hereby is adopted:

Section 1 of Resolution No. 2022-25-L shall be amended to include:

1. That the maximum speed limit on Pratt Road from its intersection with U.S. Highway 59/U.S. Highway 160 to the city limits of Parsons, Kansas shall be 45 miles per hour.
2. That the maximum speed limit on Ness Road from its intersection with U.S. Highway 166 to the city limits of Altamont, Kansas shall be 45 miles per hour.
3. That the maximum speed limit on Scott Road from its intersection with U.S. Highway 59/U.S. Highway 160 north to 16,500 Road shall be 30 miles per hour.
4. That the maximum speed limit on Scott Road from its intersection with U.S. Highway 59/U.S. Highway 160 south to 12,000 Road shall be 30 miles per hour.

Section 2 of Resolution No. 2022-25-L shall be amended to include:

Pratt Road	From the intersection of U.S. Highway 59/U.S. Highway 160 and Pratt Road to 18,000 Road	4 miles
Scott Road	From the Intersection of U.S. Highway 59/U.S. Highway 160 and Scott Road north to 16,500 Road	2.5 miles

Scott Road

From the Intersection of U.S. Highway 59/U.S.
Highway 160 and Scott Road south to 12,000 Road

1 mile

Former resolutions, 2012-12-L and Resolution 2022-25-L remain and are hereby incorporated to work in conjunction with another. This resolution amends those sections of 2022-25-L as listed above.

This is an ordinary home rule resolution and shall become effective upon its publication in the official newspaper of the County, and the prohibitions and restrictions provided in this resolution shall become effective, after publication and upon the posting of traffic control signs as required by this Resolution.
